

## **Service Opportunities - Act V Emergency Shelter**

The city of Laguna Beach has created a shelter that will operate Nov. 12 thru mid-June 2010 at the peripheral parking lot called Act V (*past the Canyon Acres stoplight on Laguna Canyon Rd*). Unlike the Cold Night Shelters we've had in the past, it will be available every night. To encourage use of this shelter, we've been asked that those who provide food to our homeless people, bring it to Act V rather than Heisler Park.

### **Volunteer Positions Available:**

**Meals:** Evening meal (coffee and paper goods are provided). Eventually we hope for 7 groups of 5 to 30, each with a chairman, taking a night of the week to donate food prepared to serve as a picnic meal; i.e., casseroles, chili, salads, veggies, soup, sandwiches, something for vegetarians, small & less messy, dessert). A night or 2 ahead, your chairman will be notified of recent attendance numbers. Food needs to be on the tables **as close to 6:30 as possible**. The best entrance is on the Laguna Canyon Rd side – enter the fence area and use the ramp. Bring serving utensils. Take leftovers home.

### **Evening hosts-** DAILY (1-2 people, 6: to 9: pm)

Meet bus, greet at door, help with meal, help with storage, one-on-one support with clients. (There will be some table games.) Two Friendship Shelter supervisors will be in charge.

**Morning hosts -** DAILY (1-2 people, 5:30-7:30am.) Help with breakfast, storage, clean up and a morning smile. Again, Friendship Shelter supervisors will be in charge.

**Laundry:** WEEKLY laundry/bleaching – could be done at Laundromat, or the Resource Center but we need a couple volunteers to do the work. Launder blankets and towels/washcloths. Detergent, bleach supplied.
