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| <b>ASL</b>   | Alternative Sleeping Location - refers to both program and shelter site on Laguna Canyon Road operated under contract with City of Laguna Beach. About 30-35 people sleep at this shelter site each night.   |
| <b>B1 or B2</b>  | Bonus Project 1 or 2 (Permanent Supportive Housing programs from HUD)  |
| <b>BHP</b>   | Bridge Housing Program - refers to both program and shelter site on S. Coast Hwy. 30 people sleep at this shelter site each night  |
| <b>CalAIM</b>  | California Advancing and Innovating Medi-Cal - a new initiative in CA to revamp Medi-Cal. As a CalAIM provider, FSI receives ongoing funding for supportive services in shelters, outreach and housing. Through the program we can also access one-time housing support to help a person move in to housing. |
| <b>CES</b>   | Coordinated Entry System   |
| <b>EHV</b>   | Emergency Housing Voucher  |
| <b>ESG</b>   | Emergency Solutions Grant / Shelter Grant  |
| <b>HDAP</b>  | Homeless Disability Advocacy Program - funds outreach and some services  |
| <b>HFS</b>   | Housing Focus Shelter - program approach at ASL + BHP  |
| <b>HH</b>  | Henderson House - refers to both program and housing location in San Clemente for TAY  |
| <b>PSH</b>   | Permanent Supportive Housing   |
| <b>RRH</b>   | Rapid Re-Housing - new housing program starting 4/1/2021   |
| <b>SL</b>  | Silver Lantern - Permanent Supportive Housing location in Dana Point   |
| <b>STH</b>   | Short Term Housing - OCHCA Behavioral Health contract for beds at BHP  |

| <b>WHOC CESH</b>                     | Welcome Home OC - United Way Program that contracts with us for some housing-related services  |
| <b>WPC</b>                           | Whole Person Care - funding program (now ended) that pays for housing services - we subcontracted under AFH  |
